- The October Fly In went very well. It was a beautiful day. We had 35 pilots and netted \$990.31. Many thanks to all those who helped set up, participated, and helped clean up.
- The members in attendance at the October club meeting voted to suspend accepting new member applications for now. The reasoning is that we only want the current membership to be able to decide what becomes of the club and its assets. We also voted to suspend dues for 2019 and allow all 2018 members to carry over into 2019. The reason is that we need a membership body to vote on any proposed actions concerning a new location or disposal of assets. The officers can only dispose of assets after the club actually dissolves.

- We are planning on things from the field to keep (store at John Starnes' place or at Blue Ridge or Triple tree) – we will uproot the fence posts and save the chain link fence. We will uproot the parking area fence posts and save them as well. We will keep the breaker box and breakers, as many outlets as we can salvage, and any other electrical item(s) that seems potentially usable – the fan, the light, whatever else looks good. Also the flag pole, flag, and windsock.

We are offering the carport to anyone who is willing to remove it and pay a little bit for it. Please make a proposal before the next meeting (November 19, 2018 at the A&P Restaurant in Greer).

It has been suggested that the 8X8 building might be “disassembleable”. I don't think that's a word and I also don't think it can be done. Someone else suggested that it might be possible to load it onto a flatbed truck and move it. If you are interested in it, please let us know before the next meeting. Otherwise, it will be left for “dozer food”.

Starting stands – we plan to divide them up among the clubs where our members “land” – Blue Ridge, Foothill Flyers and possibly Currys Lake.

Tables and benches – make us an offer if you have a use for one. Otherwise they will be offered to the other clubs as well.

Also at the meeting, we voted to allow Garret and Carlos to lay down the felt material that will help the jets and micros get off the ground. I suppose they will remove it when we leave.

If I have missed something (I just remembered the microwave), please let me know and I will take it up with the other officers and discuss it at the next meeting.
