### Communications

At the August meeting it was decided that since we have the field until mid-December, we will have one more fund-raiser Fly-In on Saturday October 13, 2018.

On August 1, 2018, John Dillewyn and Bob Jackson met with three representatives from ReWa. Access to the Durbin Creek Wastewater Treatment site is highly unlikely because of their solar panel arrays and an existing lease arrangement with someone who grows hay and maintains the fields. However, the leader of the ReWa group said that he would look at some of their other properties to see if there was anything that we might be able to use in a "mutually beneficial" arrangement. We are waiting for a response.

There is no change in the status of the Enoree landfill as a potential RC field. The project is very costly and the completion date is difficult to predict. Access is also less than ideal. The attitude of the neighbors is still unknown and there are other neighborhoods nearby that could prove problematic. For those reasons, Enoree is on hold for the foreseeable future.

We will probably have a last social event at the field closer to the final exit date. That will be discussed at a future meeting. The officers are starting to make plans for the assets at the field - the carport, the small building, the fencing, the starter stands etc. I will be sending an update on the status of the assets as well as the status of Blue Ridge and our plans for 2019.
